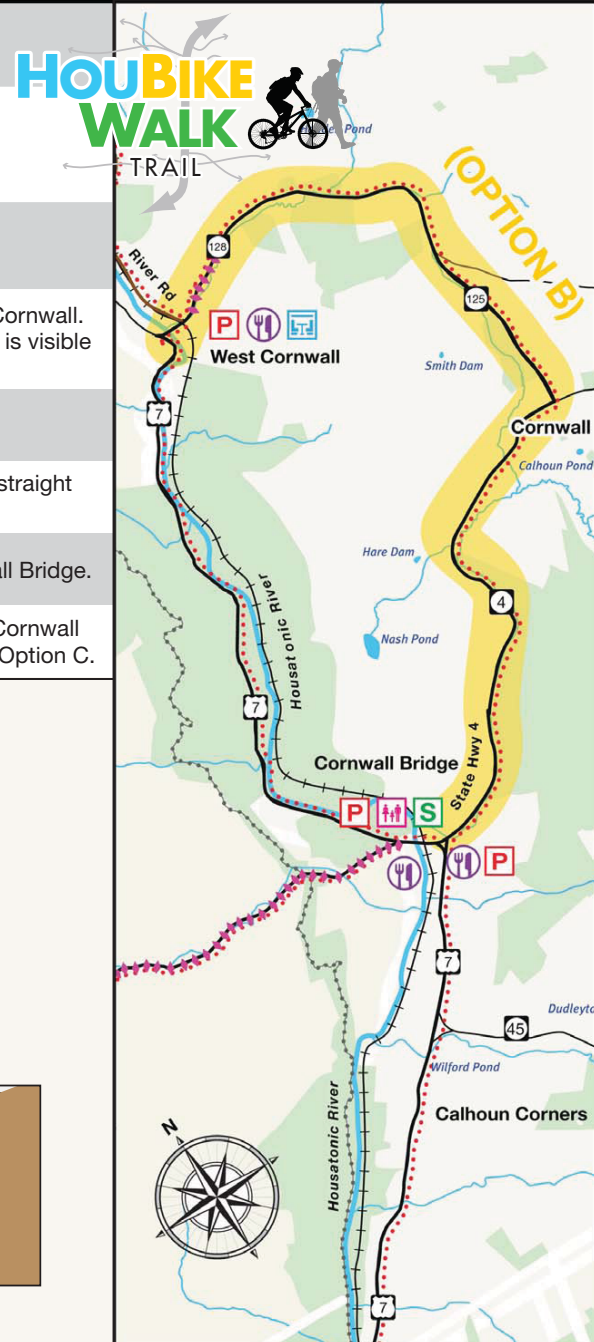
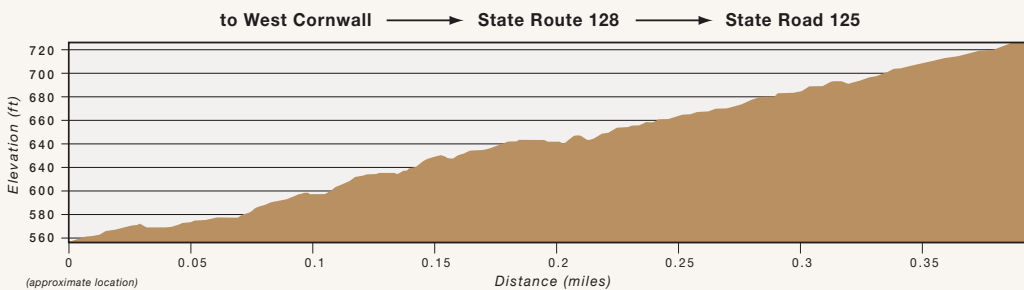


### West Cornwall to Cornwall Bridge (Option B)

Distance Between Points	Total Distance	DIRECTIONS	NOTES
Better for Less Experienced Cyclists – But with More Hills. Starting at intersection of River Rd and Rt. 128.			
0	0	L at SS onto Rt. 128	This is the hamlet of West Cornwall. The famous Covered Bridge is visible on right
2.3	2.3	BR onto Rt. 25	
1.3	3.6	R onto Rt. 4 West	The hamlet of Cornwall is straight ahead.
3.3	6.9	L onto Rt. 7 South	This is the hamlet of Cornwall Bridge.
0.1	7.0	S at SS onto Rt. 7 South	Back on main Route. See Cornwall Bridge to Kent Directions or Option C.

R – Right Turn    S – Straight    BL – Bear Left  
L – Left Turn    TL – Traffic Light    BR – Bear Right  
SS – Stop Sign    Y – Yield Sign
