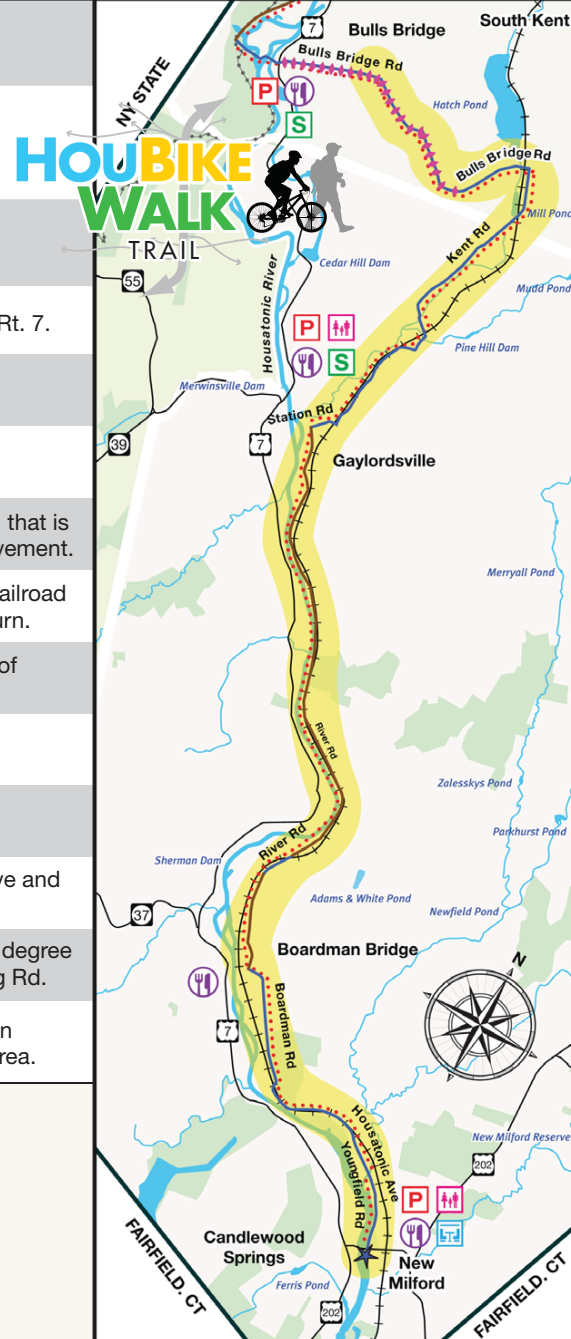


Bull's Bridge to New Milford

Distance Between Points	Total Distance	DIRECTIONS	NOTES
Section of Dirt Road Passable on a Road Bike. Section after River Road is for Experienced Cyclists.			
0.1	33.5	S at TL onto Bulls Bridge Rd	This is the intersection with Rt. 7.
2.3	35.8	R at SS onto South Kent Rd	
1.4	37.2	L onto Long Mountain Rd	
0.1	37.3	BR onto Browns Forge Rd	Long Mountain is the dirt road that is straight ahead; stay on the pavement.
1.0	38.4	R onto Station Rd	Poorly marked intersection. Railroad tracks immediately after turn.
0.1	38.5	L onto River Rd	Approximately 3.6 miles of River Rd are dirt.
4.4	42.9	L at SS on Boardman Rd	
1.3	44.2	S - Boardman Road Becomes Housatonic Avenue	
0.3	44.5	S at SS	Intersection of Housatonic Ave and Aspetuck Ridge Rd
0.3	44.8	S - onto Young Rd	Housatonic Avenue makes 90 degree turn. Go straight onto Young Rd.
0.5	45.3	S at intersection of Young Rd and Rt 202	Trails End! You are now in New Milford's downtown area.

R - Right Turn S - Straight BL - Bear Left
L - Left Turn TL - Traffic Light BR - Bear Right
SS - Stop Sign Y - Yield Sign
