0.03	4.3	R onto Rt. 126	
0.03	4.3	L onto boinay Hill Rd	Short steep hill!
0.8	5.1	R at SS onto Sand Rd	
2.1	7.2	L at SS onto Rt. 126	Rt. 126 is Point of Rocks Rd. Railroad tracks immediately after turn.
1.4	8.6	S at SS	Rt. 126 makes a left – stay straight.
0.07	8.6	R at Y onto Sand Rd	Go through the railroad underpass.
0.04	8.6	L onto Warren Turnpike Rd	

R – Right Turn S – Straight BL – Bear Left
L – Left Turn TL – Traffic Light BR – Bear Right
SS – Stop Sign Y – Yield Sign
