Y - Yield Sign

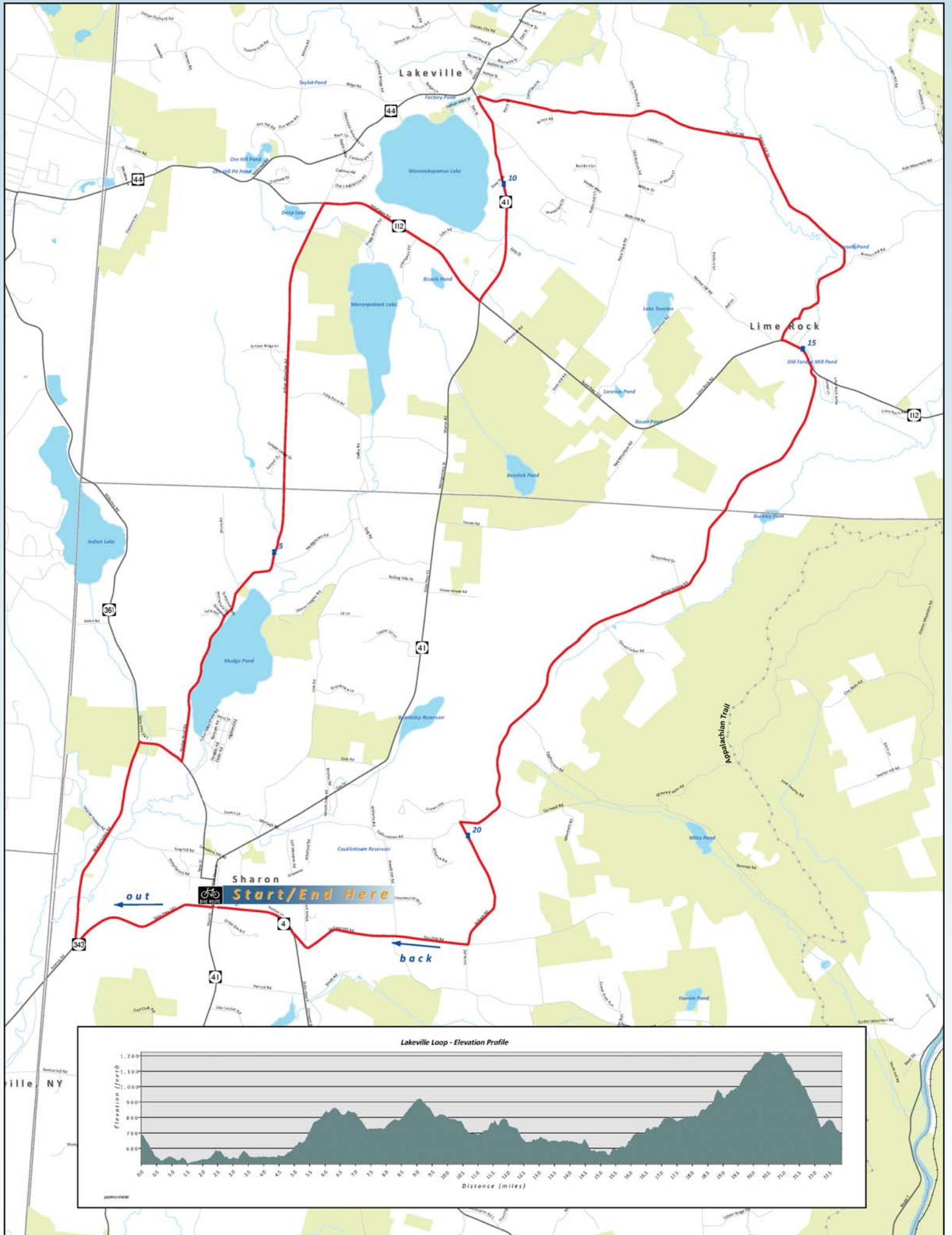

Sharon - Lakeville Loop

This 22.7 mile ride starts at the Sharon Town Green and takes you through some classic New England farm country – especially along Farnum Road and White Hollow Road. There are some great views from the top of Jackson Hill Road. The Sharon Town Green and Lakeville are the only places along this route to re-supply.

Difficulty: This ride is hilly and there is a fast technical downhill from the top of Jackson Hill Road. The short stretch of Route 41 into the center of Lakeville can get busy with local traffic and the shoulder is limited in spots. All the roads are paved.

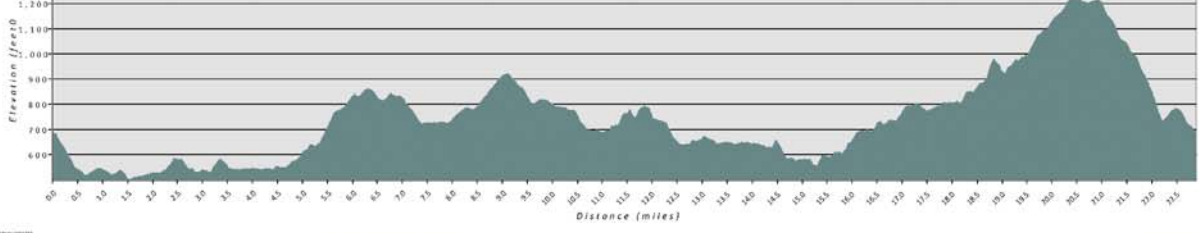

0.0	0.0	Starting at the SS the intersection of Rt. 4, Rt. 41 and Rt. 343, go West on Rt. 343 (Amenia Rd.).	The Sharon Clock tower is at the south east corner of this intersection.
1.1	1.1	R onto Sharon Valley Rd.	
.9	2.0	S at SS – stay on Sharon Valley Rd.	This is a four way intersection.
0.7	2.7	BR at SS onto Rt. 361 (Millerton Rd)	
0.3	3.0	L onto Mudge Pond Rd.	
1.7	4.7	S on Mudge Pond Rd.	Mudgetown Rd. is on your right.
.6	5.3	Mudge Pond Rd. becomes Indian Mountain Rd.	
2.2	7.5	R at SS onto Rt. 112 E	This is Interlaken Rd.
1.4	8.9	L at SS onto Rt. 41 N	This is Sharon Rd.
1.6	10.5	R onto Farnum Rd.	
2.1	12.6	R at SS onto Salmon Kill Rd.	
2.0	14.6	L at SS onto Rt. 112	This is Lime Rock Rd.
0.3	14.9	R onto White Hollow Rd	
4.4	19.3	R at SS onto Calkinstown Rd	
0.3	19.6	L onto Jackson Rd.	
1.0	20.6	R at SS onto Fairchild Rd	
0.6	21.2	S onto Jackson Hill Rd. Road names changes; no stop sign.	Jackson Hill Road is a fast, curvy downhill with great views straight ahead. Want to admire the views? Stop first!
0.8	22.0	R at SS onto Rt. 4 W	
0.7	22.7	SS at Intersection of Rt. 4, Rt. 41 and Rt. 343	End of Route
