Three half-day field visits to engage with new content, resources, and teaching strategies. Scheduled to align with cohort members' availability. Release time authorized by Region 1 administration.

Virtual Peer Feedback Sessions | Winter 2023, Spring & Summer 2024

Three short virtual sessions to share progress and access additional resources to support field trip planning.

Lesson Implementation and Student Field Trips | Spring & Fall 2024

Teacher implementation of lessons/activities, including student field trips to UHVNHA heritage sites.
